### **ENTRIES CLOSE – October 5, 2020**

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Plug Inns are \$25 +GST/Night
- Hotel Discounts \$100/Night @ Stampeder Inn, \$109/Night @ Canalta (Use “Northern Alberta Reined Cowhorse Club Event” to book with discount)
- Video fees are as follows;
  - \$47.25 – Futurity/Derby (GST Included)
  - \$21 – Horse Show Classes (Per day, GST Included)
- Entries must be paid on or before October 12, 2020. Payment can be made by:

- If competing in Futurity, Derby, or NRCHA approved classes, owners and riders must have NRCHA and NARCHC memberships. If competing only in NARCHC approved classes, owner and rider must have NARCHC memberships.
- Membership and non pro declaration(if applicable) must be signed and sent in prior to showing.
- NARCHC rules apply to all NARCHC approved classes \ NRCHA rules apply to all NRCHA approved classes; please refer to the NRCHA/NARCHC rulebook at <http://nrchadata.com/pdf/news/2020/2020RuleBookWebFile.pdf>

- An owner may enter multiple horses, a rider may compete on multiple horses, but a horse may only be entered once in each division.
- The NARCHC reserves the right to accept or reject any entry. All board decision are final.

- The NARCHC reserves the right to cancel, transfer or reschedule the event without notice or liability. In the event of a cancellation, all entry fees paid to date will be refunded. Any interest accrued on the entries is the property of NARCHC.
- All entries must include a copy of the horse's registration papers, NRCHA grade competition license, or a written veterinary age authentication. Failure to include any of the above will constitute an incomplete entry.
- These rules and conditions may change to better enhance the show. Any changes will be decided and presented by the NARCHC Board of Directors &/or Committee on behalf of the NARCHC Board of Directors.
- Entry confirmation will be sent out and posted once all entries have been received.

**\* By entry submission you are acknowledging that you and/or your horse meet the criteria to compete in selected classes. Riders are responsible to check and confirm entry before they compete.\***

## **STALLS**

- Stalls can be moved in on Wednesday October 14, 2020 after 4pm.
- Contestants are responsible to check in with the barn office to get stalls unlocked.
- Stalls include two bags of shavings; bags of shavings can be purchased on site.
- Stalls are \$45/1 Night, \$65/ 2 Nights, \$85/3 Nights, \$105/4 Nights

## **PRACTICE WORKS**

- Pricing is as follows; \$60/ Fence, \$100/ Cutting (2 cows)
- October 15, 2020 - Herd Work Practice will start at approximately 5 pm
- October 16, 2020 – Herd / Fence Practice Works will start at approximately 3 pm.

## **NARCHC FUTURITY & NORTHERN METALLIC DERBY**

1. Futurity & Derby entries will be accepted until October 5, 2020. Late entries will be accepted with an additional two hundred dollars (\$200.00) late fee up to cattle order date.
  - a. All entries must include a copy of the horse's registration papers, NRCHA grade competition license, or a written veterinary age authentication. Failure to include any of the above will constitute an incomplete entry.
  - b. Competitors must enter online @ <https://www.narchc.com/enter.html>.
2. Horses of any breed can compete if they meet the NRCHA requirements.
3. A **Futurity** entry is open to any three year old. An entry consists of 3 events; Herd work, Reined work, and Fence work, which each horse must compete in. Horses must be shown in a snaffle bit that meets the requirements set forth in the NRCHA rulebook.
4. A **Derby** entry is open to any 4 or 5 year old horse (6 year old's may be shown in the non pro ltd but must be shown in a snaffle). An entry consists of 3 events; Herd work, Reined work, and Fence work, which each horse must compete in. Horses must be shown in either a hackamore or snaffle bit that meets the requirements set forth in the NRCHA rulebook.
5. Any non pro showing a grade horse, must provide proof of ownership.

**6. Non pros cannot show under a transfer report. The registration must be transferred to the competitor prior to the show.**

**HORSE SHOW**

1. Horse show entries will be accepted until October 5, 2020. Late entries will be accepted with an additional fifty dollar (\$50.00) late fee up to cattle order date.
  - a. Competitors must enter online @ <https://www.narchc.com/enter.html>
  - b. All entries must include a copy of the horse's registration papers, NRCHA grade competition license, or a written veterinary age authentication. Failure to include any of the above will constitute an incomplete entry.
2. For classes that are NRCHA approved, competitor can choose to enter NARCHC class, NRCHA class, or both classes. **Fees dependent on entered classes.**
  - a. To enter an NRCHA approved class rider/owner must have a current 2020 NARCHC and NRCHA membership.
  - b. To enter an NARCHC approved class rider/owner must have a current 2020 NARCHC membership.
  - c. NRCHA classes run concurrently within NARCHC classes.
  - d. Payout based on each associations payout schedule.
3. Classes that run concurrently are as follows:
  - a. Open/Intermediate/Ltd. Open Bridle
  - b. Non Pro/Intermediate/Novice/Select Non Pro Bridle
  - c. Smokums Prize Spectaculars will be run with their designated NARCHC classes (see "Smokums Prize Spectaculars")
  - d. Open/Intermediate/Ltd. Open Hackamore
  - e. \$5,000 Limit/Non Pro Limited
  - f. Youth Bridle/Youth Fence
  - g. Youth Ltd/Youth Rein/Box

**SMOKUMS PRIZE SPECTACULARS**

- To be entered in the spectacular, you **MUST** compete in designated NARCHC classes;
  - Open Bridle Spec – Open Bridle/Two Rein Cutting & Open Bridle/Two Rein Cowhorse.
  - Non Pro/Novice Non Pro Bridle Spec – Non Pro Bridle/Two Rein Cutting & Non Pro Bridle/Two Rein Cowhorse.
  - Non Pro Ltd Spec – Non Pro Bridle/Two Rein Cutting & Non Pro Rein/Box
  - Open Two Rein Spec – Open Bridle/Two Rein Cutting & Open Bridle/Two Rein Cowhorse.
  - Non Pro Two Rein Spec - Non Pro Bridle/Two Rein Cutting & Non Pro Bridle/Two Rein Cowhorse.
  - \$1,000 Limit Non Pro Rein/Box Spec – \$1,000 Limit Non Pro Cutting / \$1,000 Limit Non Pro Rein/Box
  - \$1,000 Limit Non Pro WCH Spec - \$1,000 Limit Non Pro Cutting / \$1,000 Limit Non Pro WCH

- You only need to enter the cutting and cowhorse once each over the course of the weekend to meet spectaculars requirements. However, your highest score out of each day will be used in the aggregate. (If you enter the cutting and cowhorse classes both days your highest cutting/rein/fence score in each event is used in the spectacular aggregate)

## **SCRATCHES**

If an entry is scratched before October 12, 2020, entrant will not be responsible for entry and any prepaid fees will be refunded. After October 12, 2020 entrant will be charged add back and half of the office/cattle charge.

## **SUBSTITUTIONS**

1. Rider substitutions must be brought forth to show secretary with legitimate reasoning, board will decide if substitution is allowed.
2. Horse substitutions must be brought forth to show secretary with a copy of the new horse's papers and a new entry form, board will decide if substitution is allowed.
